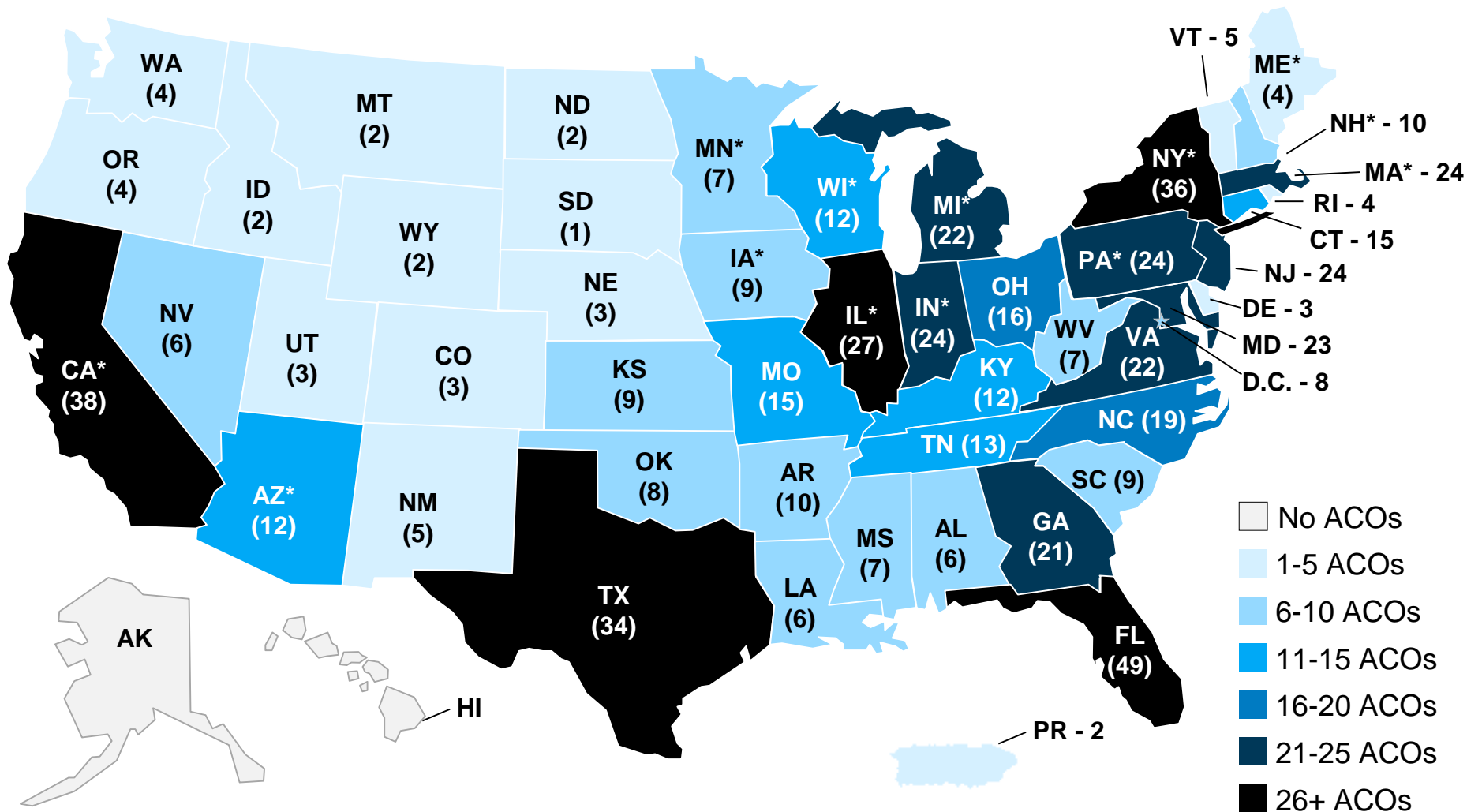


# As of January 2015, 405 MSSP and 19 Pioneer ACOs Are Operating in 48 States, Puerto Rico, and DC



ACO: Accountable Care Organization; MSSP: Medicare Shared Savings Program

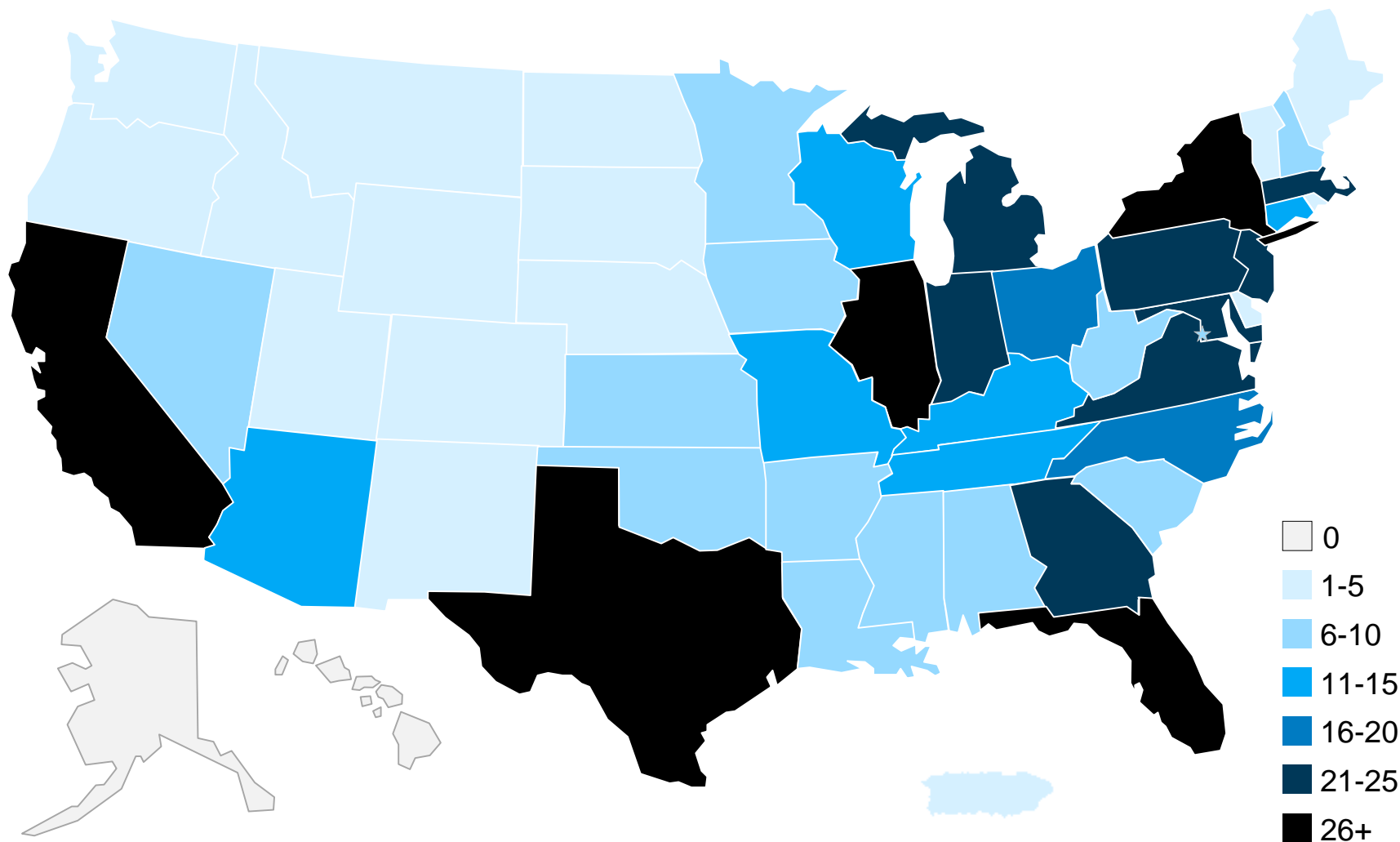

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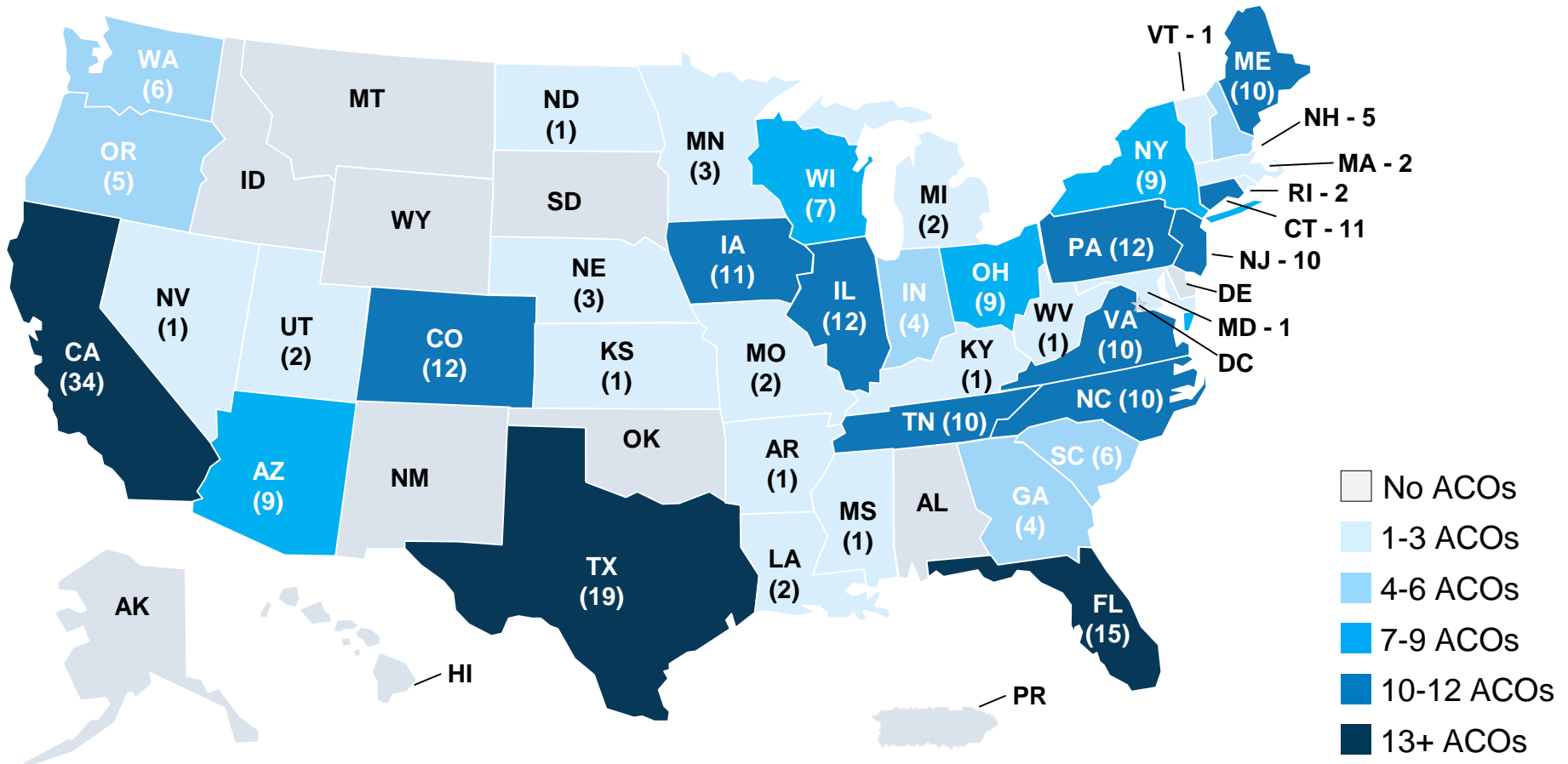
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# As of May 2015, Commercial Payers Are Sponsoring at Least 249 ACOs Across 38 States

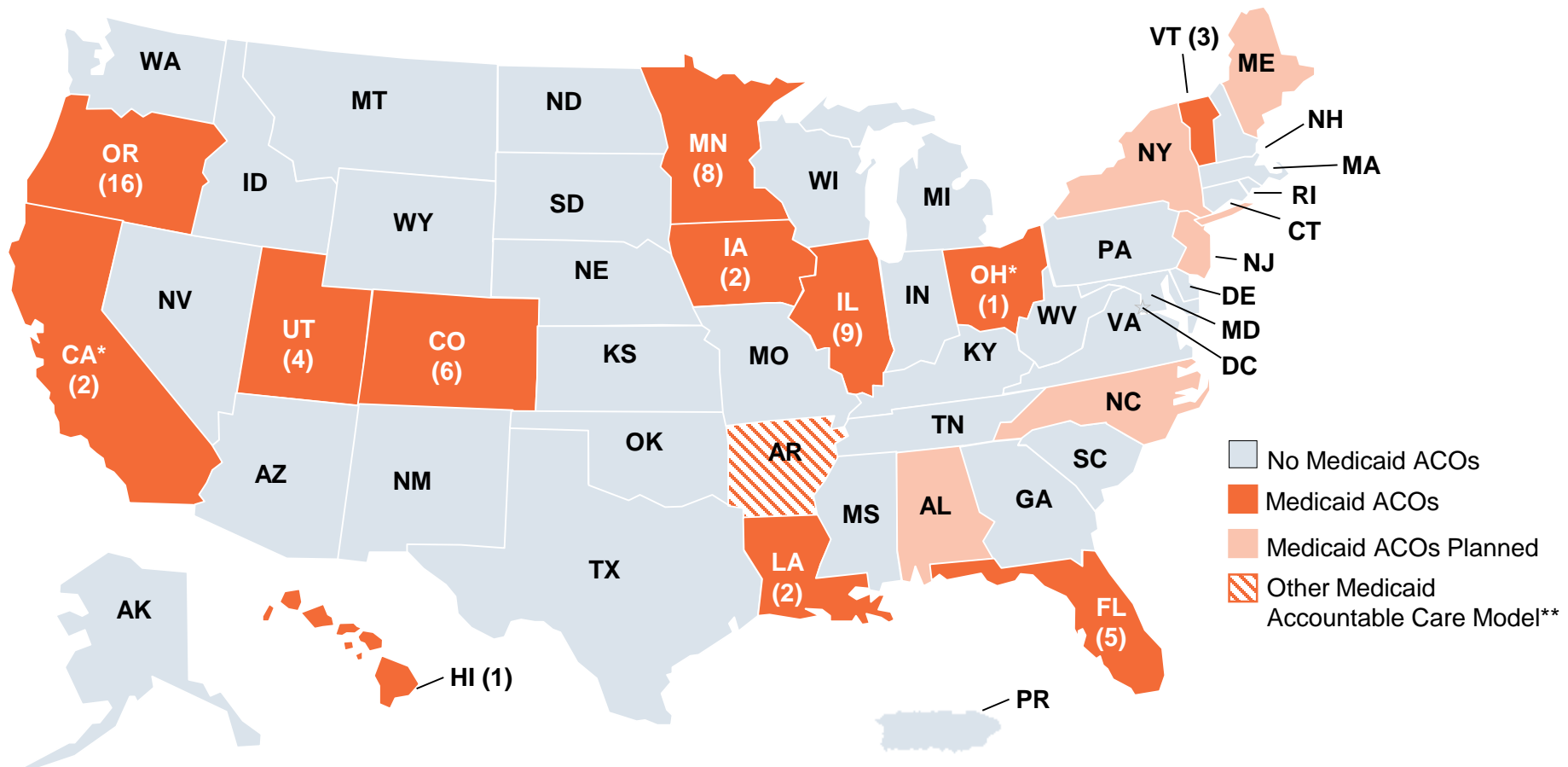
